## \$29,000 raised for aerospace students in Washington State

In 2010, PNAA established a scholarship fund to help students pursue their passion for aerospace. In its first year, the organization raised less than \$5,000 to help a handful of students with lofty dreams.

In 2019, PNAA will award \$29,000 in scholarships to northwest students. As part of its commitment to workforce development, PNAA and 12 industry businesses contributed to the Scholarship Program which will help students at 12 colleges and universities in Washington State.
