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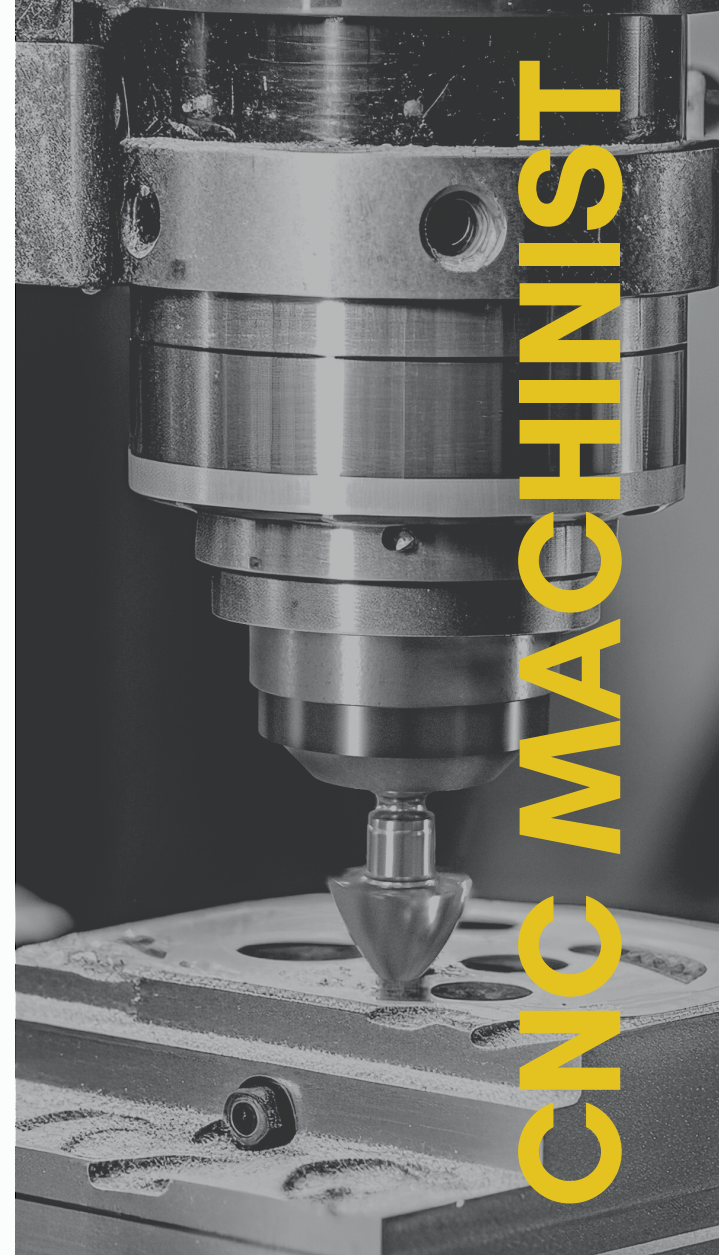

CAREER PATH

ENTRY LEVEL OPERATOR

Most entry-level CNC Machinists start as machine operators, gaining skills and experience as they progress.

CNC MACHINIST

Many Machinists transition into being put in charge of setting-up CNC machines. This includes understanding geometric dimensioning and tolerancing and making changes at the CNC machine's controller.

CNC PROGRAMMER/LEAD

As a programmer your job is to create the code that tells the CNC systems how to make the part you need. This includes programming, designing parts, optimizing performance, and inspection of parts.

MANAGER

Managers train employees in the proper use of equipment, enforce safety regulations, assign tasks, and oversee employees' work. They also interpret blueprints and develop plans for how to complete a project.
