CAREER PATH

ENTRY LEVEL TECHNICIAN

Responsible for basic fabrication tasks such as cutting, shaping, and assembling metal and composite parts.

SENIOR FABRICATOR

This role involves more complex fabrication tasks, including custom part creation and intricate assemblies. They may also guide entry level technicians, troubleshoot issues, and ensure compliance with safety and quality standards.

FABRICATION SUPERVISOR

Oversees a team of fabricators, ensuring projects are completed on time and to specification. They manage workflow, coordinate with other departments, handle administrative tasks, and mentor junior staff.

PRODUCTION MANAGER

Oversees the entire manufacturing operations, including planning, scheduling, and coordinating production activities. They ensure that production targets are met, manage budgets, and implement policies to improve efficiency and safety.
